

What you need to know for your cat's spay/neuter:

- Absolutely **no** food after midnight the night before your appointment. Water is okay).
- You will need to have an area set up for your cat to recover for about 10 days. (No running, jumping, or stairs). For females, we highly suggest a large dog crate if you are able to get one. (Cheap ones are usually available on Facebook marketplace.) This will help prevent incision complications.
- You will go upstairs (the door to the left of our main door. At the top of the stairs, the clinic is the last door on your right).
- Drop-off time: 6:30 to 8 A.M.
- Pick-up time: 2-4:30 PM the same day of your appointment.
- There is a \$40 re-booking fee if you do not show up for your appointment. For cancellations, please call 607-786-7729 twenty-four hours ahead of your appointment.
- We highly recommend a cone collar for \$10.
- A rabies vaccination is required by NYS law. If your cat does have a current rabies vaccine, we must have a copy of the rabies certificate at the time you drop-off your cat for surgery. A receipt from your vet will not work, we need an actual certificate. Please contact your vet if you need one. Anything that is not a certificate or an out-dated certificate, will be rejected. We are required to administer the vaccine if we do not have a certificate. If you need to send us a rabies certificate, you can email it to [info@animalcarecouncil.org](mailto:info@animalcarecouncil.org) at least 48 hours before your appointment. You can also bring the certificate in at the time your cat comes in for surgery.
- Please bring your cat in a carrier, not a box.
- If you have an emergency, our vet's phone number is 607-659-4220. We will not reimburse vet bills from another vet.
- If your cat is in heat, please bring her anyways.

Additional Services:

- \$40 FIV/FeLV test
- \$10 Distemper Vaccine at the time of the first shot. \$10 more at the time of the second shot. (\$20 total)

Additional Items Available for Purchase:

- a cone collar (\$10)
- broad-spectrum deworming pill (\$10)
- earmite treatment (\$10)

Our low-cost spay & neuter clinic is for cats only. The clinic on Wednesdays by appointment. Surgeries are performed by a licensed veterinarian. The appointment must be scheduled in advance. We recommend that you spay/neuter your cat at 5 months of age and they should weigh at least 4 lbs. To book an appointment, please fill out the contact form below. You should receive an email with instructions. Someone will call or email you within several days to book your appointment.

Please note: We do not have a vet on staff, so we don't offer any emergency or regular veterinary care. The only time we offer vaccinations is when you bring your cat in for her/his scheduled spay/neuter appointment. We only do a certain number of surgeries per week, so sometimes we are booking several weeks ahead from the date you make your payment. If you notice one testicle has not descended on your cat, please mention that before booking an appointment. This is called a "cryptorchid."
